**RESOLUTION OF THE PINAL COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
DECLARING A STATE OF EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, On July 28-30, 2022, a storm event produced rains in excess of a 500 year storm event; and;

WHEREAS, The rains produced heavy flooding throughout Pinal County, resulting in damages to the public infrastructure within Pinal County; and,

WHEREAS, Due to the extreme flooding an emergency now exists in Pinal County and the Pinal County Emergency Response and Recovery Plan is hereby activated and is in effect until further notice; and,

WHEREAS, The flooding caused many areas to suffer severe damage which is beyond the capability of Pinal County to recover from and provide the necessary relief, financial assistance or repair without assistance from the State; and,


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Pinal County Board of Supervisors declares a local emergency for flood damage associated with the storms of July 28-30, 2022; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Pinal County requests the State of Arizona to declare a state of emergency for Pinal County and provide disaster relief assistance from the Governor's Emergency Fund; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County, through the County manager, may provide mutual aid to other affected political subdivisions as authorized by A.R.S. § 26-311C and requests the State of Arizona and the Federal government to provide disaster relief assistance.


