NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the County of Pinal as follows:


1. Kelly Anderson's appointment to the Maricopa-Stanfield Irrigation and Drainage Board shall be corrected to a three (3) year term.

3. Dan Thelander's appointment to the Maricopa-Stanfield Irrigation and Drainage Board shall be corrected to a three (3) year term.

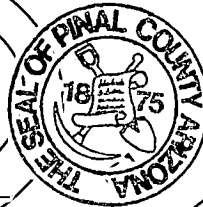



**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PINAL COUNTY
CANCELLING THE REGULAR ELECTIONS OF NOVEMBER 14, 2023 FOR CERTAIN
POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS IN PINAL COUNTY.**

WHEREAS, Pinal County is a regularly constituted and organized County within the State of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. §16-410(A), in any election that is to be held pursuant to Title 15 or Title 48 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, if the total of the number of persons who file a nomination petition for a candidate and the number of persons who file a nomination paper for a write-in candidate is less than or equal to the number of positions filled at the election for which the nomination petition or nomination paper is filed, the county board of supervisors may cancel the election and appoint the person or persons who filed the nomination petition or nomination paper to fill the position for the term of office for which the candidate was nominated; and

WHEREAS, each of the following listed elections to be held pursuant to either Title 15 or Title 48 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, for regularly constituted and organized political subdivisions within the State of Arizona and Pinal County; and

WHEREAS, for each of the following listed elections the following person, or persons, have filed a nominating petition for election to the governing board of that particular political subdivision:

2. The persons listed above are hereby appointed to fill the positions of governing board members for the terms indicated in the respective political subdivisions in Pinal County.



4. This action is taken pursuant to the authority granted the Pinal County Board of Supervisors under A.R.S. §16-410(A).


