**A RESOLUTION OF PINAL COUNTY AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY RECORDER TO OPERATE EMERGENCY VOTING CENTERS ON MARCH 18, 2024 FOR THE PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE ELECTION:**

**WHEREAS,** The Pinal County Recorder is responsible for maintaining and operating elections within the boundaries of the county, and

**WHEREAS,** it is in the best interests of Pinal County to maintain Emergency Voting Centers in the event that designated voting centers are unavailable due to unforeseen circumstances, and

**WHEREAS,** operation of an Emergency Voting Center is authorized by Arizona Revised Statutes 16-411.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the County Recorder is authorized to elect the following locations as Emergency Voting Centers for the 2024 General Election in Pinal County:






